The Neighbourhood Centre Program provides a diverse range of support services for the community. These services include:

Information, support and referral service to the Moranbah Community;

Coordinate and facilitate local workshops, forums and meetings;

Coordinate and facilitate the Moranbah Interagency Group meetings and other regional forums as required;

Take a pro-active role in assisting clients to achieve positive outcomes through holistic support services;

Community/community centre based development, coordination and support;

Development and Networking including: Men's Shed Project, Moranbah Youth and Community Centre and other ongoing projects;

Volunteer Mangement, support and referrals for clubs and groups in Moranbah.

Rural Family Support

Rural Family Support Workers at MDSS strive to assist families with children and youth aged 0-18 years to gain knowledge, skills and resources to provide for the physical, social and emotional needs of their children.

Improve the wellbeing and safety of children, young people and their families through positive family support;

Providing parenting strategies to parents and carers to build the capacity of the family to care for and protect their children;

Provide information, support and referrals to enable families to access the resources to build their capacity to problem solve and make positive choices and changes;

Assisting children and youth ages 0-18 years with self-esteem issues, risk-taking behaviours, anger management problems, risk of early school disengagement and adjustment with separation and divorce.
